What we do:

StartHub Africa is a young social start-up supporting young people to start and grow successful businesses. StartHub runs a highly practical entrepreneurship training that enables students to start a business in only one semester. The training is offered at various partner universities in and around Kampala (MUK, UCU, Kyambogo, ...) and in other cities. Local lecturers from these universities are trained to provide the students with the skills.

After they started off in the Academy, we offer follow-up support through the StartHub Catalyzer. It consists of Coaching, linking Startups to investment, offering the opportunity to access European markets via an online shop that we are building up, and to facilitate networking.

- Eventual support to other StartHub Africa working groups
